

# Flying flags at sea

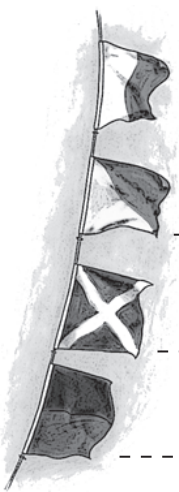


International maritime flags are used to signal between two ships or between ship and shore. There is a system of signal flags for each numeral and letter of the alphabet. Each flag or pennant also has another meaning when flown on its own.

KEY	
R	= Red
Y	= Yellow
B	= Blue
Blk	= Black
No letter	= White
